The LMC

- The LMC Committee is made up of GPs elected by their peers, representing 630 constituents from 113 GP practices. Meetings are held monthly
- The LMC Secretariat is our staff team responsible for GP and practice liaison, providing advice, co-ordinating meetings and events, and maintaining relationships with other organisations

Strategic Work

- Humber Primary Care Collaborative the collective voice of primary care, established by the LMC
- Develop local pathways and support implementation at practice and PCN level
- Provide advice on implementation of national policies at regional level
- Support cross-system working by developing relationships with other primary care contractor groups
- Represent primary care in the Humber, Coast and Vale capital steering group
- Provide input to the Humber primary care strategy

System Support

- Chair regular PCN meetings in our 4 CCG locations and work to build system relationships to benefit primary care
- Jointly lead on Primary/Secondary care interface meetings with acute trusts, driving forward shared action plans and engagement
- Provide primary care input on prescribing committees and medication management issues in all areas
- Represent providers at Primary Care Commissioning Committees and at the Council of Members in all 4 CCG locations
- Lead on 2021 racism report and delivery of racism strategy across HCV, with national recognition and invitations to speak on this work
- Set up Primary Care Against Racism Network for all primary care colleagues and allies

Development support

- Clinical Director development programme 2020/21 and 2021/22 run by Kings Fund across ICS with 22 CDs participating
- Mentor training for GPs and practice managers
- Appraiser training for practice managers

Practice support

- Practice queries performance, medical, contract, legal, HR, disputes, property, financial and pensions
- Lobbying on behalf of PCNs for realistic DES specifications, contributing to the national debate and engaging with NHSE
- Provide a two way link to the national BMA and GPCE teams
